## **Guidelines for the preparation of the article for publication**

1. Manuscripts (**original papers i review papers**) have to be send only by e-mail:

**ConferenceJP2@ukw.edu.pl**

2. **Articles must contain:**

The title of the article in the language of the article (**font 18 pt., Bold, centered, spacing 1.0 line**);

Title of the paper in English (**font 18 pt., Bold, centered, spacing 1.0 line**).

The full names of the authors in the language of the article (**14 point font., Bold, centered, spacing 1.0 line**);

Full names of authors in the English (**font 14 pt., Bold, centered, spacing 1.0 line**).

The full name of affiliated units of the authors in the article (14 point font., Centered, spacing 1.0 line);

The full names of authors affiliated units in English (font size 14, Centered, spacing 1.0 line);

Keywords (2-6) in the language of the article (**font size 12 pts.**)

Keywords (2-6) in English (**font size 12 pts.**)

Summary in the language of the article (**font size 12 pts., Justified text, line spacing 1.0**, from 1400 to 1800 characters including spaces; divided into : introduction, aim, material and methods, results, conclusions);

Summary in English (**font size 12 pts., Justified text, line spacing 1.0**, from 1400 to 1800 characters including spaces ; divided into : introduction, aim, material and methods, results, conclusions);

**Introduction** (12 point font., Justified text, line spacing 1.0);

**Aim of the study** (as above);

**Material and methods** (as above);

**Results** ( as above);

**Discussion** (as above);

### **Notes on the preparation of the text of the article (from the introduction to conclusions):**

Titles of chapters stand out in bold; turn off hyphenation; footnotes inserted automatically; do not format the spacing series of spaces, do not precede the punctuation with space; tables, charts and figures inserted in the text, numbering and table title above the table, the numbering and the title of figures or chart under the chart/figure.

## List of references (References).

Making a list of references is the responsibility of the author.

List of literature must be consistent with the principles established by the International Committee of Medical Periodicals Editors ' Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted a Biomedical Journals"(www.nlm.nih.gov/bsd/uniform\_requirements.html).

Each reference should include the names and initials of authors, title of article, abbreviated or full name of the journal, year, volume, page start and end.

If there are more than six authors, after the sixth name please add " et al ".

Abbreviated names of journals indexed in Medline (PubMed) should be administered by the NLM Catalog (<http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/nlmcatalog>), and the other in the version given by the publisher of the magazine.

Internet sources should include the date of download or view the file in brackets after the URL (Uniform Resource Locator).

Please format the punctuation according to the following examples of bibliographic description :

3. Manuscript should be prepared in MS Word editor.

4. Please, do not number the pages.

5. Volume of the manuscript is unlimited.
